- California has more death row prisoners than any other state: 725 people are on death row; 19 are women.
- Billions of dollars have been spent since 1978 to run a system that has executed 13 people.
- There is a better alternative that will put more of our resources toward unsolved violent crimes, instead of toward offenders who are already locked up in prison.
- The **California Catholic Conference of Bishops** supports Proposition 34
- Advocates of Proposition 34 simply say, *"California can't afford the death penalty!"*
